Achieving Carbon Neutrality Declaration of support for the Recommendations of the Task Force on Climate-related Financial Disclosures (TCFD)

NTT DATA Corporation

NTT DATA Corporation announces its support for the recommendations of the "Task Force on Climate-related Financial Disclosures (TCFD)" established by the Financial Stability Board (FSB) on March 30, 2021.

Going forward, the NTT DATA Group will contribute to the realization of a sustainable society by further actions to address climate change issues in its business and corporate activities.

[Background and Overview]

The NTT DATA Group has identified "Responding to climate change" as one of the key issues in "ESG Management" for its medium-term management plan (2019 – 2021 years). The NTT DATA Group has been continuously working to reduce its own greenhouse gas emissions and contribute to a reduction by society as a whole through the promotion of green innovation such as the Green Data Center[®].

We aim to contribute to carbon neutrality 2050 for society as a whole through "Green Innovation", and to achieve the SBT¹ target for reduction of greenhouse gas emissions by 2030 (Scope 1 and 2: 60% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions in 2030; Scope 3: 55% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions in 2030)².

We support the TCFD Recommendations and will continue to actively disclose climate-related information that has impacts on our finances.

(Note 1) SBT (Science Based Targets): Targets in line with what the latest climate science for corporate greenhouse gas emissions reduction based on the Paris Agreement. Targets will be approved by the "SBT Initiative" for climate change action, in collaboration between the United Nations Global Compact (UNGC), CDP (Former Carbon Disclosure Project), the World Resources Institute (WRI), and the World Wildlife Fund (WWF).

(Note 2) Scope 1: Direct emissions of greenhouse gases by businesses, such as fuel combustion

Scope 2: Indirect emissions from the use of electricity, heat and steam supplied by other companies

Scope 3: Indirect emissions other than Scope 1 and Scope 2 (Emissions in the supply chain related to business activities)
